Heard learned counsel of the applicant appellant and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record.

The instant application seeking temporary suspension of sentence has been filed on behalf of the applicant- appellant on the ground that the marriage of his younger brother has been solemnized/fixed for 22.07.2026. A copy of the marriage invitation card has been annexed with the application in support of the said plea.

Learned counsel for the applicant- appellant submitted that the presence of the applicant- appellant is indispensable for performing the marriage ceremonies and rituals, and that there is no other male member in the family to solemnize and oversee the marriage of his younger brother. It has, therefore, been prayed

that the applicant- appellant be granted interim suspension of sentence (SOS) for 10.07.2026 to 25.07.2026 to enable him to attend and participate in the marriage ceremonies.

In this background, this Court deems it proper to accept this application for temporary suspension of sentences and enlarge the applicant appellant on interim bail for a period of **15 days**.

Accordingly, the instant application for temporary suspension of sentences filed under Section 430 of BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the sentences passed by the learned Special Judge, POCSO Act Cases No.02, Bhilwara, vide judgment dated 21.11.2025 in Sessions Case No.108/2025 against the appellant-applicant **Jai Kumar Alias Jai Prakash S/o Mukesh Kumar**, shall remain temporarily suspended and he shall be released on interim bail for a period of **15 days** from the date of his release, provided he executes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sound and solvent sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge on usual terms and conditions and upon submitting an undertaking that he shall surrender back upon expiry of the period of temporary suspension of sentences. The Superintendent of the concerned Jail shall give the date of surrender of the applicant -appellant Jai Kumar Alias Jai Prakash S/o Mukesh Kumar.
