1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner, who claims himself to be the husband of the corpus



Mst. 'D'. It is stated that the corpus Mst. 'D' is in illegal detention of the private respondents.

3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'D' has been produced before us.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'D'. The corpus Mst. 'D' has stated before us that she is 26 years of age, has educational qualification uptill 8th standard and understands her well-being fairly well. She has further stated that she started living with the present petitioner under some misconception and now she desires to live with the private respondents with whom she is living happily without any pressure. She has also stated that she is not in illegal detention of any person including the private respondents and she does not want to live with the present petitioner anymore.

5. Having considered the statements made by the corpus Mst. 'D' before us, we are of the opinion that since the corpus Mst. 'D' is a major lady, who understands her well-being fairly well and she is living with the private respondents of her own free will, and she is not in illegal detention of any person including the private respondents, therefore, there is no force in the present habeas corpus petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
