1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the
mother of the corpus Mst. 'J' alleging therein that she is in illegal
detention of respondent No.5.
3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the
corpus Mst. 'J' has been produced before this Court.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'J'. She has stated that she is a major lady married to respondent No.5 and living happily with him at her matrimonial house without any pressure from any side. She also stated that she is not in illegal detention of any person including respondent No.5.

5. After hearing the statements made by the corpus Mst. 'J', learned counsel for the petitioner was asked that on what ground the present habeas corpus petition for illegal detention has been filed. He replied that petitioner has received a call from the corpus that she is being ill-treated at the hands of the respondent No.5, therefore, this habeas corpus petition has been filed. Even the corpus Mst. 'J' has stated that neither respondent No.5 has ever ill-treated nor has assaulted her.

6. In this view of the matter, we feel that filing of this petition is nothing but an abuse of process of law. The present habeas corpus petition is, therefore, devoid of any force and the same is, hereby, dismissed.
