1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicants-accused **1. Aman S/o Jafar Ali 2. Samroj S/o Mohammad Jafar 3. Ayan Ali S/o Jafar Ali 4. Jafar Ali S/o Gulam Mohammmd** seeking bail in



respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.144/2026 dated 08.06.2026 registered at P.S. Mukta Prasad Nagar, District - Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 109(1), 115(2), 189(2), 331(5) of BNS.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and they are no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicants accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicants undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the complainant Jakir Hussain has lodged a report against four named and unknown persons about incident which was sudden and unintentional. He submitted that it was a free fight and the injured have suffered simple injuries. He also submitted that except one criminal case there is no other case against the petitioners.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor and learned counsel for the complainant. Learned counsel for the complainant has referred the photograph and the injury and submitted that the act of present petitioner is grave in nature.
5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.



6. On basis of a report dated 08.06.2026 lodged by Jakir Hussain against Aman, Ayan, Samroj, Jafar and one unknown person about alleged assault in the evening of 07.06.2026 involving present petitioners and 50-60 other persons, an FIR No.144/2026 was registered and the police has investigated the matter and arrested present petitioners who are in custody. We have considered injury report as referred during course of arguments and also considered the submissions.
7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicants-accused **1. Aman S/o Jafar Ali 2. Samroj S/o Mohammad Jafar 3. Ayan Ali S/o Jafar Ali 4. Jafar Ali S/o Gulam Mohammmad**, is hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail with condition that each of the applicant-accused would furnish a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.



- (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
 - (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
