1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had filed an application form, for the post of Group Instructor/Surveyor/Assistant Apprenticeship Advisor (Grade-II) under the category of Multiple Disability, as the petitioner is suffering from Locomotor Disability ['LD'] and Hearing Impairment ['HI']. He submits that the respondents issued provisional select list in which, petitioner's roll number was present and the cut-off marks for multiple disability was reflected as 32.43. He further submits that thereafter, the respondents had issued the final

select list in which, they have indicated against multiple disability as 'N.A.' (Not Applicable). He also submits that without assigning any reason and without informing the petitioner, the respondents have not selected petitioner against the category of Multiple Disability and roll number of the petitioner is also not present in the final select list for the reasons best known to the respondent-Commission.

2. The matter requires consideration.
3. Issue notice of the writ petition along with stay application to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.
4. In the meanwhile and until next date, one post of Group Instructor/Surveyor/Assistant Apprenticeship Advisor (Grade-II) under the category of Multiple Disability, shall be kept reserved for the petitioner.
