1. These present bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicants-accused **Jagdish S/o Nathu Lal Patidar, Mani Lal S/o Gokul Patidar & Gotam Lal S/o Taged Patidar** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.108/2026 dated 13.06.2026 registered at Police Station Shrinathji Mandir, District Rajsamand, for the offence under Sections 319(2), 318(4), 61(2) & 112(2)

of BNS, 2023, under Section 66D of IT Act and Section 83(2) of JJ Act.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submit that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicants-accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicants undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants submit that on the basis of a report lodged by SHO himself these applicants-accused and other persons have been implicated in the instant case. He also submitted that there is no criminal antecedents against any of the applicants-accused. He further referred the material and submitted that the entire report is registered on the basis of a presumption by police as there is neither any complainant nor any victim who was cheated by these applicants-accused. At last he submitted that the offence is triable by Magistrate First Class.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor and he submitted that the offence is serious in nature and role and involvement of applicant is established from the material on record.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicants-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.

6. On basis of a search and seizure dated 13.06.2026 by SHO Police Station Shrinathji Mandir, Rajsamand FIR No. 108/2026 was registered at Police Station Shrinathji Mandir, District Rajsamand for alleged cyber crime by these applicants-accused. The applicants-accused were arrested on 13.06.2026 and since then they are in custody. There is no criminal antecedents against them. The report is registered by police on the basis of certain analysis though there is no statement of victim on record. Not a single complainant came forward to lodge a report in the police station.
7. This Court also finds that the applicants-accused have remained in custody for a considerable period of time and that the trial/proceedings are likely to take further time to conclude. Therefore, looking to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
8. Thus, these instant bail applications filed on behalf of applicants-accused **Jagdish S/o Nathu Lal Patidar, Mani Lal S/o Gokul Patidar & Gotam Lal S/o Tajed Patidar** are hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount by each of the applicant-accused to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.

- (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
 - (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
