Order

1. These bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicants-accused **Rajveer Singh S/o Indra Singh and Yogendra Singh S/o Indra Singh** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.123/2026 dated 26.05.2026 registered at P.S. Kotwali, District- Churu, for the offence under Sections 115(2), 140(3), 307, 127(2) and 189(2) of BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more

required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. The applicants do not have any criminal antecedents. He also submits that the applicants undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that this Hon'ble Court has already granted bail to Om Giri S/o Shri Devi Giri vide order dated 01.07.2026, and the case of both the petitioners is at parity with that of Om Giri. He further submitted that the entire material on record clearly indicates that the injured, at the most, suffered simple injuries and that no case under Section 109(1) of the BNS is made out from the injury report. He also submitted that there are no criminal antecedents against the petitioners and that neither of the petitioners is related to the victim or the complainant.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail applications and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.
5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On 01.07.2026, we considered the bail application of Om Giri under Section 483 of the BNSS and observed as under:

"6. On the basis of the report lodged by complainant Krishan Kumar on 26.05.2026 regarding the incident of 25.05.2026, FIR No. 123/2026 was registered at P.S. Kotwali Churu, District- Churu, against 17 named and one

unnamed person. During investigation, the present petitioner was arrested on 28.05.2026 and since then he has been in custody. The petitioner was not named in the FIR."

7. The material on record clearly indicates that there are no criminal antecedents against the petitioners, and both the petitioners have been in custody since 26.05.2026. The issue that has arisen in the present case is that the complainant lodged a report against the family members and others of a girl who was forcibly kidnapped from a public office.
8. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
9. Thus, the instant bail applications filed on behalf of applicants-accused **Rajveer Singh S/o Indra Singh and Yogendra Singh S/o Indra Singh**, are hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail with condition that each of the petitioner would furnish a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.

- (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
