1. The instant bail application has been filed by the applicant **Vikram @ Pahalwan S/o Ashok Kumar** under Section 483 BNSS against the order impugned passed by learned court below in connection with **FIR No.505/2025** registered at **Police Station Sangaria District Hanumangarh** for the offence(s) under **Sections 103(1), 332(2), 61(2), 111(2)(A), 111(3), 111(4), 111(5) BNS.**
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the case. Challan has been filed. He submits that the co-accused Akashdeep, Makhinder Singh @ Lovely, Manpreet Singh @ Mani, Gurnam Singh and Arvind Delu @ Dara have been enlarged on bail by this Court on 18.5.2026, 22.5.2026, 27.3.2026 in which it is mentioned that main accused is Jalendhar Singh @ Amratpal who actually shot the bullet and Hardeep's presence with Akashdeep has been captured on CCTV. He further submits that the applicant is behind the bars and trial may take long time to conclude thus, he deserves to be enlarged on bail.

3. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

4. Considering the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, and looking to the overall facts and circumstances of the case, without commenting on the merits and demerits of the case, this court deems it just and proper to enlarge the applicant on bail.

5. Accordingly, the bail applications under Section 483 BNSS are allowed and it is ordered that the accused-applicant shall be enlarged on bail in the aforesaid FIR provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned Lower Court for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
