Order

The matter comes up on the application (I.A. No.1/2026)
seeking early listing of the case.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is
allowed.

With the consent of the parties, the matter is taken up today
for consideration.

By way of the present civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought following reliefs :-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that this writ petition may kindly be allowed and by an appropriate writ, order or direction:-

- i. The Respondents No. 2 and 3 may be directed to issue affiliation /recognition to the Petitioner institute to conduct B.Sc. (N) course for the academic session 2026-27 for 60 seats;*
- ii. The Petitioner may be permitted to undertake B.Sc. (N) course for the academic session 2026-27;*
- iii. The Respondents may also be directed to conduct the inspection of the Petitioner Institute in terms of the NOC dated 04.07.2025 (Annex. 2);*
- iv. That the Respondent no. 2 may further be directed to verify the new address of the Petitioner and issue the necessary certificate for the new address.*

V. Any other appropriate relief which this Hon'ble Court deems just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of the Petitioner.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, in view of the order dated 04.07.2026 (क्रमांक प 25 (9) चिस्वा./ग्रुप-3/2024 जयपुर) passed by the Medical & Health (Group-3) Department, Government of Rajasthan, the principal relief claimed in the present writ petition stands redressed, rendering the petition infructuous. However, it is contended that the grievance pertaining to Prayer No.4, seeking a direction to respondent No.2 to verify the petitioner's new address and issue the requisite certificate, survives. It is, therefore, prayed that the petitioner be permitted to submit a representation before respondent No.1 – Secretary, Medical & Health Department, Government of Rajasthan, Secretariat, Jaipur, and respondent No.2 – Registrar, Rajasthan Nursing Council, Jaipur, with a direction for its expeditious consideration.

Learned counsel for the respondent(s) raise no objection.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioner to submit a detailed representation, supported by all relevant documents, before respondent Nos.1 and 2 within a period of two weeks from today. Upon receipt thereof, together with a certified copy of this order, the respondent Nos.1 and 2 shall consider and decide the said representation by a reasoned and speaking order, strictly in accordance with law, within four weeks, thereafter.

It is clarified that the aforesaid direction is confined to ensuring expeditious consideration of the petitioner's grievance and shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the claim or as a direction to decide the matter in any particular manner.

The stay application and the pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
