1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in similar
controversy, a Coordinate Bench of this Court of this Court in the
case of ***Prahalad Singh Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.:***
SBCWP No.12211/2025 has granted interim order on

03.07.2025 while staying the effect and operation of the order by which the recovery has been ordered.

2. The aforesaid interim order dated 03.07.2025 is reproduced hereunder:

- “1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is working in the respondent department on the post of Assistant Engineer and without holding any enquiry in the matter, an order dated 21.04.2025 has been passed, whereby, recovery of an amount of Rs.12,06,945/- has been ordered against the petitioner. He further submits that the action of the respondents is in violation of the principles of natural justice.
3. Matter requires consideration.
4. Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also, returnable on 30.07.2025.
5. Meanwhile and till the next date of hearing, effect and operation of the order dated 21.04.2025 shall remain stayed, if the same has not been given effect to till date.”

3. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks. Issue notice of the stay application as well.

4. In the meanwhile and until the next date of hearing, effect and operation of the order dated 28.04.2026 (Annex.P/7) shall remain stayed, if the same has not been given effect to till date.

5. Connect with SBCWP No.13694/2026, 12211/2025 & 12414/2026, as prayed.
