1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in an identical controversy bearing SBCWP No.15735/2025 : "Vikash Manda & Ors. v. RPSC & Ors.", the Coordinate Bench has granted interim order by issuing notices to the respondents. He further

submits that the petitioners are aggrieved of the condition laid down in the advertisement which states that persons enrolled with Rajasthan State Veterinary Council are only entitled to apply in the selection process, is arbitrary and bad in the eyes of law, whereas, the petitioner has acquired Bachelors Degree in Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry from College of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry, R.K. Nagar, Agartala, Tripura University, and is registered under Tripura Veterinary Council.

2. **Admit.**

3. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.

4. Notices when issued, be given '*Dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for effective service.

5. In the meanwhile and until next date, the respondents are directed not to reject the applications of the petitioners applying the condition that the petitioners shall comply the condition of provisionally or regularly registered with the Rajasthan State Veterinary Council.
