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**HON'BLE MS. JUSTICE REKHA BORANA**

**Order**

**07/10/2024**

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide Annexure-7, a direction has been issued to call for new NITs for the services to be rendered qua Model Schools on the premise that while issuing the earlier work orders, a compliance of the provisions of the Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Act, 2012 (for short 'the Act of 2012') and Rules of Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2013 (for short 'the Rules of 2013') was not made.

Learned counsel submits that the said order is totally erroneous as the earlier NITs had been invited perfectly in terms of the Act of 2012 and the Rules of 2013 and the work orders had been issued to the petitioner after following due process of law and till date, the petitioner is rendering its services in compliance of the said work orders.

2. In view of the submissions made, Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also.

Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due. Notices be made returnable on 11.11.2024.

Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.

3. Meanwhile, the respondent authorities shall be restrained from preventing the petitioner from performing its function in pursuance to the orders (Annexure-6 collectively) whereby the work for the Session of 2024-25 had been extended.
