1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner, who claims himself to be a live-in-partner of the corpus



Mst. 'R' and it is stated that the corpus Mst. 'R' is in illegal detention of the private respondents.

3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this court, the corpus Mst. 'R' has been produced before this Court.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'R'. She stated that she is 26 years of age and is pursuing her post B.Sc. Course, understanding her well being fairly well. She stated before us that she is capable of taking decisions in the best of her interest. She stated that she is happily living with the private respondents, who are her parents without any pressure from any side. She stated that she is a friend of the present petitioner, but they never live in live-in-relationship. She has expressed her desire to go and live with her parents only.

5. In view of the statements made by the corpus Mst. 'R' before us, this Court is convinced that the corpus Mst. 'R' is not in illegal detention of any person including private respondents.

6. The present habeas corpus petition is, therefore, fails, and the same is hereby dismissed.

7. The amount deposited by the petitioner in pursuance of the directions issued by this Court on 09.07.2026 stands forfeited.

8. The investigating agency is directed to see to it that the corpus Mst. 'R' reaches her residence safely.
