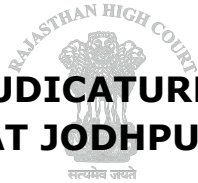

1. This criminal misc. application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner for extension of time of emergent parole granted to him by this Court for a period of 30 days in *DBCRLW No.2619/2026* vide order dated 12.06.2026.

2. It is apprised to this Court that the emergent parole was granted to the petitioner for a period of 30 days on the ground of ailment of her son and daughter who were suffering from serious ailment.

3. The present is a follow-up case of interlocking femur nail fixation with the implant still in situ. Implant removal has been advised. The treating orthopedic surgeon has opined that surgical intervention is required and that the procedure should be undertaken at the earliest. Now, as the doctors have advised the son of the petitioner to undergo surgery as soon as possible because it could not be done before due to unstable health, an extension has been sought for further period so that operation of the petitioner's son can be done.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer for extension of time of emergent parole.

5. Upon consideration and taking a lenient view, the instant application is allowed and the period of interim bail is further extended by 30 days.

6. The petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Jail Authority in the morning of the next day of completion of the period of emergent parole.

7. This order shall be treated as part and parcel of the order dated 12.06.2026. passed by this Court in *DBCRLW No.2619/2026*.
