The present interim bail application under Section 483 of BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner on the ground that his mother has expired on 25.06.2026 and his presence is required for performing last rites and rituals of his mother.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the presence of petitioner is essential in order to perform the last rites and rituals of his mother. It is therefore, prayed that the petitioner may be released on interim bail for a period of 30 days.

Learned Public Prosecutor has not disputed the factum of petitioner's mother passing away.

Looking to the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, a humanitarian approach is required to be adopted, thus, this Court deems it just and proper to enlarge the petitioner on interim bail for a period of 15 days.

Accordingly, the interim bail application filed under Section 483 of BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed and it is directed that petitioner **Poonaram S/o Shri Arjunram** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.678/2022, registered at Police Station Suratgarh City, District Sri Ganganagar, for the offences under Sections 8/15, 25 of the NDPS Act, be released on interim bail for a period of **15 (15) days**, subject to the condition that he shall deposit a sum of **Rs.5,00,000/-** before the trial court and provided he furnishes a personal bond in a sum of **Rs.4,00,000/-** with two sound and solvent sureties in the sum of **Rs.2,00,000/- (out of which one surety will be a close relative of the petitioner)** each to the satisfaction of learned trial court for his surrender on completion of 10 days from the date of actual release.

If the petitioner surrenders within the stipulated period before the concerned Jail, then the amount of Rs.5,00,000/- so deposited before the trial court shall be refunded back to him whereas if the petitioner fails to surrender within the stipulated period, then the amount so deposited shall be forfeited immediately.

Let this bail application be again listed on 28.07.2026. Learned Public Prosecutor shall be required to submit the compliance report of the order as to whether the petitioner has surrendered or not.
