1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the mother of the corpus Mst. 'M' alleging therein that the corpus Mst. 'M' is in illegal detention of the private respondents.

3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'M' has been produced before us.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'M'. The corpus Mst. 'M' has stated that she is 19 years of age, has attained qualification of 11th Standard and understands her well-being fairly well. She has further stated that she has solemnized marriage with respondent No.4 of her own free will and without any pressure from any side. She has also stated that she is not in illegal detention of any person including respondent No.4 and she has expressed her desire to go and live with the respondent No.4 only.

5. In view of the statements made by the corpus Mst. 'M' before us, we are convinced that the corpus Mst. 'M' is not in illegal detention of any person including the respondent No.4. Thus, the present habeas corpus petition is devoid of any force and the same is hereby dismissed.
