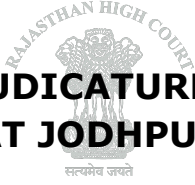

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner, who claims himself to be the husband of the corpus Mst. 'B' and it is stated that the corpus Mst. 'B' is in illegal detention of the private respondents.
3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this court, the corpus Mst. 'B' has been produced before this Court.
4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'B'. She stated that she is 21 years of age, having educational qualification of 9th class

and understands her well being quite well. She stated before us that she was forcefully taken away by the petitioner, who happens to be the cousin brother of the corpus. She stated that the petitioner was blackmailing her on account of the certain nude photographs of her and, therefore, she was forced to sign certain documents. She stated that she is not in illegal detention of any person including private respondents. She has expressed her desire to go and live with her parents. She stated that she is not in illegal detention of any person including private respondents.

5. In view of the statements made by the corpus Mst. 'B' before us, this Court is convinced that the corpus Mst. 'B' is not in illegal detention of any person and since she is a major lady of 21 years of age, therefore, she is free to go and live at a place and with a person of her choice.

6. The present habeas corpus petition is, therefore, fails, and the same is hereby dismissed.

7. The amount deposited by the petitioner in pursuance of the directions issued by this Court on 09.07.2026 stands forfeited.
