Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was afforded appointment on contractual basis as teaching associate against the sanctioned post of Assistant Professor in the Engineering & Technology Centre for Disaster Management of Technology for Animal on 16.01.2018. He submits that since then the petitioner is continuously discharging the duties on the aforesaid post to the satisfaction of the respondents and his

engagement has been continuously extended by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the post of Assistant Professor, Disaster Management in the stream of Disaster Management of Technology for Animal is still lying vacant, however, the respondents without issuing prior notice have orally terminated the services of the petitioner w.e.f. 22.06.2026. He submits that the respondents have not sought any explanation from the petitioner and neither there is any adverse remark against the petitioner. He also submits that as the post of Assistant Professor in the Project Disaster Management of Technology for Animal, Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Science, Bikaner (RAJUVAS) has been still lying vacant and has not been filled with the regularly selected employee, the respondents ought not to have discontinued the services of the petitioner in an arbitrary manner.

2. In view of the submissions made, issue notice to the respondents. Issue notice of the stay application as well.
3. In the meanwhile and till the next date, the respondents are directed to continue the petitioner on the same post, on which he was discharging his duties, till the regularly selected employee is not made available.
