1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, vide order dated 16.07.2025, was given the licence for a model shop in Barmer provided she deposits an amount of Rs.35,69,233/- pursuant to the condition No.4.4 of the Model Retail Shop Policy dated 09.06.2025. He further submits that the respondents on the very next day has issued an amended/revised offer vide letter dated 18.07.2025, wherein, an amount of Rs.50,30,000/- has been demanded in place of Rs.35,69,233/-.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the order dated 18.07.2025 has been issued in violation of the provisions of condition No.4.4 of the Model Retail Shop Policy dated 09.06.2025.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of writ petition to Mr. Mahaveer Bishnoi, learned AAG, who shall complete his instructions on or before the next date of hearing.
6. List on 28.07.2025.
7. In the meanwhile and till the next date of hearing, the licence of the petitioner issued on 16.07.2025 and 18.07.2025 shall not be cancelled provided the petitioner deposits an amount of Rs.6,00,000/- by 05:00 pm today i.e. on 22.07.2025 before the District Excise Officer, Barmer.
8. The petitioner will be free to submit a Demand Draft of Rs.6,00,000/- (Six Lakhs) before the District Excise Officer, Barmer instead of depositing the amount online.
9. Learned counsel for the respondents assures this Court that in the event of Demand Draft being presented before 05:00 pm today, the same shall be accepted.
