1. The present writ petition has been filed with the following prayers:-

“(a) By, an appropriate writ, order or direction, the impugned order dated 07.07.2026 (Annex-3) passed by the respondent No.2 may kindly be quashed and set aside qua the petitioner.

(b) Any other appropriate order or direction, which this Hon'ble Court considers just and proper in the facts and circumstances of this, may kindly be passed in favor of the petitioner.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner while placing reliance on the order dated 19.06.2026, submits that the respondents have taken a policy decision that, while effecting transfers, priority shall be given to cases involving single women, widows, abandoned women, etc., however, despite the petitioner falling within the category of a Divorcee, she has been transferred from Government Senior Secondary School, Biladi, Banswara to Government Senior Secondary School, Thummath, District Banswara, vide order dated 10.07.2026 (Annexure-3). She submits that the respondents have not adhered to their own order dated 19.06.2026 while passing the impugned transfer order.

3. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned AGC appearing on behalf of the respondents and he submits that due to administrative exigency the transfer has been effected but considering the grievance as raised by the petitioner, the petitioner is free to make a representation before the Grievance Committee constituted vide office order dated 17.07.2026 for resolving the issues pertaining to single women/widow/divorcee/employees suffering grave illness and many other issues. He submits that the petitioner can file her representation before the Grievance Committee, which will consider the representation on the grounds raised by the petitioner in an expeditious manner and this petition can be disposed at this stage.

4. Heard.

5. Taking into consideration the fact that the respondents have transferred the petitioner, a Divorcee woman, without taking into consideration her difficulty and also the fact that a Grievance Committee has been constituted vide office order dated

17.07.2026, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to file her representation before the Grievance Committee within a period of '7 days' from today and the Committee shall decide the representation within a period of '10 days' thereafter, strictly in accordance with law by way of passing a speaking order.

6. Till the decision of the representation, the impugned order dated 07.07.2026 (Annex.3) shall remain stayed qua the petitioner, in case, the petitioner has not joined at the new place of posting.

7. It is made clear that if the petitioner fails to file the representative within a period of '7 days' from today, the interim order granted by this Court shall stand vacated automatically.

8. With the aforesaid directions, the writ petition is disposed of.
