1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Sachin Kumar S/o Moharsingh** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No. 05/2026 dated 30.04.2026 registered at Police Station Cyber Police Station (Churu), District Churu, for the offence under Sections 318(4) & 316(2) of BNS, 2023 and under Section 66C and 66D of IT Act.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant-accused from the

jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that on basis of unauthorized police analysis FIR has been registered and on basis of a report lodged by police present applicant-accused was arrested on 22.05.2026 and after conclusion of investigation a charge-sheet has already been filed. He also submitted that none of the complainant or victim from whom account the money was allegedly transferred to petitioner's account was not arrayed as a witness. He also submitted that now a charge-sheet has already been filed.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor and he submitted that the offence is serious in nature and role and involvement of applicant is established from the material on record.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of a certain analysis made by head constable Rakesh Kumar of Police Station Cyber District Churu about alleged use of petitioner's bank account FIR No. 05/2026 was registered at PS Cyber Police Station District Churu and present applicant-accused was arrested on 22.05.2026 and a charge-sheet is filed against him. There is one criminal case registered at PS Cyber (West) Gurugram.
7. This Court also finds that the applicant-accused has remained in custody for a considerable period of time and

that the trial/proceedings are likely to take further time to conclude. Therefore, looking to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.

8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Sachin Kumar S/o Moharsingh**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
