Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner-Institute is a duly recognized Minority Educational Institution imparting teacher education courses and is entitled to fill 51% of its sanctioned intake under the Minority Quota, with the remaining 49% earmarked for non-minority candidates. It is submitted that for the Academic Session 2026–2027, PTET-2026 was held on 14.06.2026, the result was declared on 25.06.2026, and the first round of counselling commenced on 06.07.2026. It is further submitted that despite repeated representations, the

respondents have failed to provide any mechanism for furnishing the list of eligible unallotted candidates, thereby frustrating the petitioner's right to fill its sanctioned Minority Quota seats. It is further submitted that a Coordinate Bench of this Court had granted interim relief vide order dated 01.08.2024 in ***Mata Gujar Khalsa Sikshan Sansthan v. State of Rajasthan & Ors. (S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.12325/2024)***, though the writ petition was subsequently dismissed in the same terms as S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.13330/2018, vide order dated 15.10.2025.

The matter requires consideration.

Issue notice to respondent(s), returnable within six weeks.

Meanwhile, the respondent(s) shall supply list of available students to the petitioner-Institution after the first counselling is over so as to enable it to fill the vacant seats of minority quota as per procedure.
