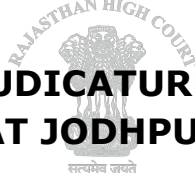

The present writ petition has been preferred by the petitioner
with the following prayers :

"i By an appropriate writ order or direction in the nature thereof thereby, the Impugned Order dated 21-5-2026 (Annex.1) issued by the respondent no. 5 may kindly be declared illegal and be quashed and set aside.

ii By or appropriate writ order an direction in nature thereof thereby, the respondents be directed to continue the petitioner as Teacher (Grade-III) Level -1 at Govt. Primary Secondary School, Tejasar, Tehsil Deedwana District Deedwana-Kuchaman.

iii By an appropriate writ order or direction in the nature thereof thereby, the action of the respondents be declared illegal by which they have posted the petitioner as Booth Level Officer.

iv. Any other order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit, just and proper in the facts and

circumstances of the case may also be passed in favour of the Petitioner.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents are directed to decide the representation of the petitioner expeditiously.

In view of the limited submissions made, the petitioner would be at liberty to file a detailed representation before the respondents within a period of two weeks from today.

In case, the representation is filed by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the same within a period of four weeks thereafter strictly in accordance with law by way of passing a speaking order.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
