Order

1. Petitioner is before this Court seeking quashing of order dated 12.05.2026 vide which he was transferred from the Government Senior Secondary School No.3 Mundara Chhapar, District Churu to the PM Shri Government Senior Secondary School, Amarpura, District Balotra (Balotra).
2. At the very outset, both the learned counsels are in consensus that in view of the order dated 28.04.2025 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in ***Poonma Rama Vs. State of Rajasthan: S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 8749/2025***, in case

the petitioner also approaches the competent authority by filing a representation within a period of two weeks from today, the same can be taken up on the administrative side in light of the applicable guidelines/circular issued by the Department and appropriate orders be passed accordingly.

3. In view of the aforesaid joint request, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority that in case if petitioner files a representation within a period of two weeks as above, an administrative decision shall be taken as expeditiously as possible. Till the decision is taken, the impugned order of transfer qua the petitioner shall remain stayed, in case, the petitioner has not joined at the new place of posting.

4. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not file representation within two weeks, the interim order granted by this Court shall stand vacated.

5. All pending applications stand disposed of.
