The present criminal misc. petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of BNSS against the order dated 03.07.2026 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Degana, Merta (Nagaur) in Criminal Case No.83/2021 for the offence under Section 138 NI Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case the petitioner is ready to mediate and already deposited the amount of cheque. However the learned trial Court has rejected the same. He further submits that there are chances of mediation.

The matter is hereby referred to the Mediation Centre attached to this Hon'ble Court.

The details of respondent No.2, including the contact number, shall be provided by the learned counsel for the petitioner before the Mediation Centre within a period of two days. Upon receipt of the same, the Registry shall issue notice to respondent No.2 and call upon her to appear in the mediation proceedings.

The parties shall appear before the learned Mediator on 05.08.2026.

List this matter soon after culmination of the mediation proceedings.

Till the mediation proceedings are concluded, no final order in the matter shall be passed. However, it is made clear that this order of protection is only passed in order to make the mediation fruitful and if the mediation fails, the Court shall consider granting/extension of the interim order on merits.

It is expected by the learned counsel for the petitioner to play a positive role and assist in mediation between the parties.

A copy of this order shall be sent to Mediation Centre.
