1. The present writ petition has been filed with a prayer that the
respondent-Authorities be directed not to retire the petitioner till
he attains the age of 65 years.

2. The petitioner has already retired on 31.07.2026, having attained the age of 60 years.
3. However, keeping into consideration the fact that the petitioner was working as 'Junior Teacher' since 01.07.1999 on contract basis, he would be at liberty to file a representation in terms of circular dated 11.07.2017 for reinstatement on contractual basis as the said circular provides for extension in service of the employees working on contractual basis till they attain the age of 65 years.
4. The representation, if filed within a period of two weeks from now, shall be considered in accordance with circular dated 11.07.2017 by the respondent-Authorities within a period of four weeks thereafter. The decision, whatsoever, be communicated to the petitioner within a period of one week from the date of such decision.
5. Keeping into consideration the limited prayer as made, no prejudice would be caused to the respondents and therefore, the requirement of issuance of notice/service on respondents is dispensed as no reply in present matter would be required.
6. With the above observations, the present writ petition is disposed of.
7. Stay petition and pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
