1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the controversy involved in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the judgment dated 20.01.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 14638/2019, Chandra Kanta v. State of Rajasthan & Anr.**

and the batch of connected writ petitions. He submits that the Coordinate Bench, while allowing the said writ petitions, held that transfer orders whereby the petitioners were transferred from their respective Panchayat Samitis without specifying the place of their posting/joining could not be sustained.

2. Learned Caveator prays for short time to complete his instructions.

3. List the matter on 17.07.2026 after reflecting the name of Mr. Kuldeep Vaishnav, Dy.G.C. as counsel appearing for the respondents in the cause list.
