Order

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner
is suffering from various illnesses like prostate, heart diseases and
glaucoma, however, the respondents, without taking into
consideration the illness of the petitioner, have transferred the
petitioner from the Office of Zonal Chief Engineer, Bikaner to the
Office of Chief Engineer, Jodhpur.
2. Learned counsel representing the petitioner, at the outset,
makes a limited submission that the respondents may be directed

to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner by way of passing a speaking order, strictly in accordance with law within a particular time period.

3. Learned caveator does not oppose the limited submissions made by counsel for the petitioner.

4. In light of such limited submission, it is hereby directed that the petitioner shall submit a detailed representation along with all his medical reports to the respondents for ventilating his grievances within a period of 'two weeks' from today. The representation of the petitioner shall be decided by respondents, by way of passing a speaking order strictly in accordance with law within a period of 'four weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

5. Till the decision of the representation, the impugned order dated 10.07.2026 (Annex.6) shall remain stayed qua the petitioner, in case, the petitioner has not joined at the new place of posting.

6. It is made clear that if the petitioner fails to file the representation within a period of 'two weeks' from today, the interim order granted by this Court shall stand vacated automatically.

7. With the aforesaid directions, the writ petition is disposed of.
