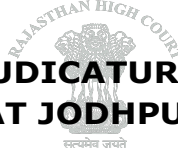

1. Heard learned counsel for the State.
2. The counsel for the petitioner is not present, however, the petitioner present in person in the Court. He states that he is living in live-in-relationship with the corpus Mst. 'S' and it is stated that the corpus Mst. 'S' is in illegal detention of private respondents.
3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'S' is produced before this Court.
4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'S'. She stated that she is 36 years of age. She stated that she is married to the respondent No.5 and is having two children out of the wedlock. However, on account of marital discord between the parties, she expressed her desire to not to live with her husband anymore. She stated that she wants to go and live with the present petitioner. She stated that she is not under any pressure from any side.
5. In view of the statements made before us by the corpus Mst. 'S', we are of the view that since the corpus Mst. 'S' is a major lady of 36 years of age, who understands her well being quite well and she has expressed her desire to go and live with the present petitioner, therefore, she is free to go and live with the present petitioner at her own choice.
6. The present Habeas Corpus Petition is disposed of and the corpus Mst. 'S' is free to live with the present petitioner at her own choice.



7. The investigating agency is directed to see to it that the corpus Mst. 'S' reaches at a place of her choice safely.

8. It is directed that the amount deposited by the present petitioner in pursuance of the directions issued by this Court on 14.07.2026 shall be refunded to the petitioner forthwith.
