1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Duli Chand @ Devil S/o Satpal** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.145/2026 dated 17.06.2026 registered at P.S. Khajuwala, District - Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 305(a) and 331(4) of BNS, 2023
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the

applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the petitioner is not involved in the incident rather his house has been used by other accused for storing the money stolen from the house of father-in-law of accused Sohan Lal. He also submitted that ₹7,65,000/- has already recovered from the possession of the petitioner and remaining money is in possession of other accused. He also submitted that he has not received any other amount and the offence is triable by Magistrate of First Class.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of a report dated 17.06.2026 about alleged theft of ₹ 22 Lacs by Dulichand, Sohanlal and Buta Singh from the house of the complainant an FIR No.145/2026 was registered by complainant Girdhariram. During investigation present petitioner was arrested and at the instance of present petitioner ₹7,65,000/- were recovered. There is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner.
7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case

and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.

8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Duli Chand @ Devil S/o Satpal**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
