Order

1. These bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS are filed by the applicants-accused **Mahendra @ Manoj S/o Sitaram** and **Omprakash S/o Vijaypal**, seeking bail in

respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.255/2026 dated 23.06.2026 registered at P.S. Shri Dungargarh, District - Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 318(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 341(1) and 61(2)(a) of BNS, 2023.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more required in investigation. They further submit that there are no chance of fleeing of applicants accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. The applicants do not have any criminal antecedents. They also submit that the applicants undertake not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners referred FIR registered by Police and submitted that the report itself indicate that 13 packets having resemblance like currency packets were recovered from possession of the present petitioner but the report itself indicate that first and last currency note of each of the packets, was currency note of ₹500/- denomination but 98 others are blank white papers. They further submit that neither any complaint is filed about cheating nor any attempt is referred to show any act to prepare fake currency note. They also submit that there is no criminal antecedents against the petitioners-accused.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail applications and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.

5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On basis of an interception on 23.06.2026 Suresh Gurjar, ASI, PS Shri Dungargarh, District Bikaner, 13 packets having resemblance like cash packets of currency notes of ₹500/- denomination were recovered and on search, the police has found that in each of the packet, first and last note were currency note of ₹500/- and in between them, there were 98 blank white papers but packets were prepared in a manner that they give resemblance of ₹500/- note packet and an FIR No.255/2026 dated 23.06.2026 was registered at P.S. Shri Dungargarh, District - Bikaner, for the offence under Sections 318(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 341(1) and 61(2)(a) of BNS, 2023. There is no criminal antecedents against the petitioners-accused.
7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail applications filed on behalf of applicants-accused **Mahendra @ Manoj S/o Sitaram** and **Omprakash S/o Vijaypal**, are hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail with

condition that each of the petitioner would furnish a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.
