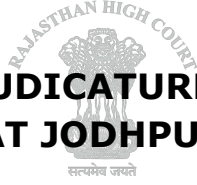

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner, who claims to be the husband of the corpus Mst. 'K' and it is stated that she is in illegal detention of the private respondents.
3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this court, the corpus Mst. 'K' has been produced before this Court.
4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'K'. She stated that she is 23 years of age, having educational qualification of senior secondary and understands her well being quite well. She stated before us that the petitioner has solemnized marriage with her by playing fraud. She was kept in detention for a period of four months and when she got the chance, she immediately fled away from the clutches of the petitioner. She further stated that she is happily living with her parents and she is not in illegal detention of any person including private respondents.
5. In view of the statements made by the corpus Mst. 'K' before us, this Court is convinced that the corpus Mst. 'K' is not in illegal detention of any person including private respondents.

6. The present habeas corpus petition is, therefore, fails, and the same is hereby dismissed.

7. The amount deposited by the petitioner in pursuance of the directions issued by this Court on 14.07.2026 stands forfeited.
