Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was issued a show cause notice dated 09.06.2026 alleging use of unfair means during the examination and was directed to appear before the Committee on 20.06.2026. It is submitted that the said notice was, however, delivered to the petitioner only on 22.06.2026. In support thereof, a copy of the postal receipt (Annexure-4) has been placed on record. It is, therefore, contended that on account of delayed service of the notice, the petitioner could neither appear before the Committee on the scheduled date nor submit a reply pursuant to the said show cause notice.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner's B.A. II Back Examination and IV Semester Examination are scheduled to commence from 18.07.2026. It is, therefore, prayed that the petitioner may be permitted to submit a reply to the show cause notice dated 09.06.2026 and, in the meantime, be provisionally permitted to appear in the aforesaid examinations.

Learned counsel, Ms. Adwaita Sharma, appearing on behalf of the respondent(s), submits that in the event the petitioner submits a reply, the same shall be considered by the Committee expeditiously.

In view of the aforesaid, the petitioner is permitted to submit a reply to the show cause notice dated 09.06.2026 on or before 21.07.2026. The respondent(s) shall consider the petitioner's reply, if so filed, and place a report before this Court on 24.07.2026.

Meanwhile, the respondent(s) are directed to provisionally permit the petitioner to appear in the B.A. II Back Examination and IV Semester Examination commencing from 18.07.2026.

It is, however, made clear that the petitioner's appearance in the aforesaid examinations shall remain purely provisional and shall be subject to the decision/report of the Committee.
