1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the
petitioner, who claims himself to be the live-in-partner of the
corpus Mst. 'P' and it is alleged that the corpus Mst. 'P' is in illegal
detention of the private respondents.



3. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'P' is produced before this Court.

4. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'P'. She stated that she is 22 years of age, who understands her well being quite well. She stated that she was living with the present petitioner, however, the private respondents forcefully took her away from the custody of the petitioner. She expressed her desire to go and live with the present petitioner only. She has stated that she is under no pressure to accompany the present petitioner.

5. In view of the statements made before us by the corpus Mst. 'P', we are of the view that since the corpus Mst. 'P' is a major lady of 22 years of age, who understands her well being, and she has expressed her desire to go and live with the present petitioner, therefore, she is free to go and live at a place and with a person of her own choice.

6. The present Habeas Corpus Petition is disposed of and the corpus Mst. 'P' is free to live with the present petitioner at her own choice.

7. Learned GA-cum-AAG is directed to make necessary arrangements of police personnel to escort the corpus Mst. 'P' from the Court to the place where she wants to go.

8. It is directed that the amount deposited by the present petitioner in pursuance of the directions issued by this Court on 14.07.2026 shall be refunded to the petitioner forthwith.
