1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's wife is also a government servant and the respondents without adhering to their own policy of keeping husband and wife at the same place of posting have transferred the petitioner from PM Shri Seth Ramdayal Rathi Government Senior Secondary School, Suratgarh, District Sriganganagar to Saheed Omprakash Bishnoi Government Senior Secondary School, Khajuwala, District Bikaner.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that vide office order dated 17.07.2026, a Grievance Redressal Committee has been constituted in respect to transfer of single women/widow/divorcee/employees suffering from terminal illness

and various other issues. He submits that the petitioner can file his representation before the Grievance Redressal Committee, which will consider the representation on the grounds raised by the petitioner in an expeditious manner and this petition can be disposed at this stage.

3. Heard.

4. Taking into consideration the grievance raise herein and also the fact that a Grievance Redressal Committee has been constituted vide office order dated 17.07.2026, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to file his representation before the Grievance Redressal Committee within a period of '7 days' from today and the Committee shall decide the representation within a period of 'two weeks' thereafter, strictly in accordance with law by way of passing a speaking order.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the writ petition is disposed of.

6. Till the decision of the representation, the impugned order dated 07.07.2026 (Annex.3) shall remain stayed qua the petitioner.

7. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to file a representation within a period of one week from today, the interim order granted by this Court shall stand vacated automatically.
