1. Referring to the order dated 3rd March, 2017, made in the
case of ***Chhoga Lal Kharol Versus State of Rajasthan &
Ors.: SBCWP No.14761 of 2013***; learned counsel for the
petitioner submits that for the present; the petitioner would
be satisfied, if the State-respondents are directed to
consider and decide the representation of the petitioner,
within a time frame, which he is ready and willing to address
within two weeks hereinafter.
2. In view of the limited prayer addressed; the instant writ
proceedings are closed with a direction to the petitioner to

address a comprehensive representation to the respondents ventilating his grievances.

3. In case, a representation is so addressed within the aforesaid period, the State-respondents are directed to consider and decide the same by a reasoned and speaking order as expeditiously as possible, in the backdrop of the adjudication in the case of ***Chhoga Lal Kharol (supra)***. However, in no case later than eight weeks from the date of receipt of the representation along with a certified copy of this order.
4. With the observations and directions, as indicated above, the writ application stands disposed of.
