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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE MUKESH RAJPUROHIT**

**Order**

By way of the present civil writ petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought following reliefs :-

“ It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that this writ petition may kindly be allowed with costs and by issuing an appropriate writ, order or direction,

(i) The impugned order dated 18.07.2024 (Annex. 7) passed by the Board of Revenue may kindly be quashed and set aside.

- (ii) *Consequently, the application filed by the petitioner may kindly be allowed as prayed.*
- (iii) *Any other appropriate writ, order or direction which the Hon'ble Court thinks just and fit may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner.*
- (iv) *Cost of the writ petition may be awarded.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the proceedings are presently being pursued by both parties before the learned Board of Revenue, Ajmer. In view of the aforesaid, it is prayed that the present writ petition be disposed of, with liberty reserved to the petitioner to institute a fresh petition, if the need so arises.

Accordingly, the present civil writ petition stands disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

The stay application and all pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
