Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is serving as a teacher in a government school, was performing his duties as an invigilator in the examination hall where the complainant's minor daughter was taking her Class 11 exam. The petitioner caught the minor girl red-handed while she was using unfair means to attempt her answer sheet.

The petitioner subsequently summoned the parents of the minor girl and pointed out her misconduct. An apology was tendered by her mother, and the petitioner did not pursue the matter further. However, taking advantage of the situation and fearing that the petitioner might file a written complaint against the minor daughter, which could jeopardize her future career

prospects, the mother of the minor girl lodged the present FIR as an afterthought, late in the evening at 9:00 p.m.

Issue notice. Learned P.P. accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Let the notices be issued to respondent No.2 only.

Learned P.P. seeks time to file status report.

Meanwhile, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner in connection with FIR in question. However, he shall join the investigation as and when summoned in accordance with law.
