Order

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 10.04.2026, the petitioner was deputed to discharge duties as a Census Supervisor for the census operations 2026-27. He submits that the Govt. of India vide communication dated 11.03.2026 had recommended that the employees deputed for

conducting census 2026-2027 shall neither be relieved nor transferred from his or her place of posting until completion of the census operations. He submits that however, the respondents vide order dated 07.07.2026 (Annex.5) have transferred the petitioner from Govt. Senior secondary School, Sumel, Beawar to Govt. Senior Secondary School Suradiya, District Beawar which is in contravention to the communication made by the Government of India.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that vide office order dated 17.07.2026, a Grievance Redressal Committee has been constituted in respect to transfer of single women/widow/divorcee/employees suffering from terminal illness and various other issues. He submits that the petitioner can file his representation before the Grievance Redressal Committee, which will consider the representation on the grounds raised by the petitioner in an expeditious manner and this petition can be disposed at this stage.

3. Heard.

4. Taking into consideration the grievance raise herein and also the fact that a Grievance Redressal Committee has been constituted vide office order dated 17.07.2026, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to file his representation before the Grievance Redressal Committee within a period of 10 days' from today and the Committee shall decide the representation within a period of 'four weeks' thereafter, strictly in accordance with law by way of passing a speaking order.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the writ petition is disposed of.

6. Till the decision of the representation, the impugned order dated 07.07.2026 (Annex.5) shall remain stayed qua the petitioner.

7. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to file a representation within a period of ten days from today, the interim order granted by this Court shall stand vacated automatically.
