Order

1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is working on the post of Junior Engineer and has been transferred vide order dated 10.07.2026 (Annex.4) from Payala Kalan, District Balotra to District Jalore, Rajasthan, which is approximately 112 kms away. He submit that the petitioner ought not to have been transferred in such an arbitrary manner.

2. Counsel for the petitioner makes a limited prayer that the respondents may be directed to decide the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner.

3. Counsel representing the respondent-State, does not oppose the prayer so made by counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the limited submission made, the instant writ petition stands disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to file a representation within a period of 'one week' from today and the respondents are directed to decide the said representation by passing a speaking order, strictly in accordance with law, within a period of 'six weeks' from the date of receipt of representation.

5. Till such time, the impugned transfer order dated 10.07.2026 (Annex.4) shall remain stayed qua the petitioner, in case the petitioner has not joined at the new place of posting.

6. It is made clear that in case the petitioner fails to submit representation within a period of one week from today, the interim order granted by this Court shall stand vacated automatically.

6. Stay application as well as all other pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
