1. The present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the mother of the corpus Mst. 'J', alleging therein that she is in illegal detention of the private respondents.
2. In pursuance of the directions issued by this Court, the corpus Mst. 'J' has been produced before us.
3. We have conferred with the corpus Mst. 'J'. The corpus Mst. 'J' has stated before us that she is 20 years of age, has studied uptill 12th standard and understands her well-being fairly well. She has further stated that she has solemnized marriage with the respondent No.8-Sonu and is living with him happily. She has further stated that she is not in illegal detention of any person including the private respondents. She has stated that she will go and meet her mother when she feels comfortable.
