1. The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with following prayer:-

“(i) The impugned transferred order dated 10.7.2026 (Annex-3) may kindly be quashed and set aside qua to the petitioner.

(ii) Any other appropriate writ, order direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner while placing reliance upon order dated 27.02.2025 passed by the Division Bench of this Court at Principal Seat, Jodhpur in ***D.B. Spl. Appl. Writ No.332/2025 : Pradeep Kumar Vs. State of Rajasthan and***

Ors. submits that the wife of the petitioner is posted in Tehsil Office (Revenue), Pilibanga, Hanumangarh and the present petitioner is transferred from Hanumangarh to Barmer. He also submits that it is duty of the respondents that the petitioner be transferred to the same place where her wife is working, who is also a Government servant (Land Record Inspector).

3. Considered the grievance raised herein, the petitioner is given a liberty to submit a representation to the respondents-Authority within a period of two weeks raising all grounds and the respondents-Authority are directed to decide the representation with a reasoned and speaking order within a period of 30 days from date of receipt of representation. After the order, the respondents are under an obligation to communicate the decision to the petitioner either by way of speed post or through E-mail, if petitioner has provided E-mail in her representation. If the petitioner is still aggrieved, she has a liberty to approach this Court with fresh petition.

4. In the meanwhile, impugned order dated 10.07.2026 (Annex.3) qua the present petitioner shall remain stayed till disposal of the representation, by the respondents.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition with pending application, if any, stands disposed of.

6. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not file representation within a period of two weeks from today, the interim order granted by this Court shall vacate automatically.
