1. The present writ petition has been filed with the following
prayers:-

"A. By an appropriate writ order or direction, the Transfer
order dated 10.07.2026 (Annex-3) and any Reliving
Order may kindly be quashed and set aside qua the
petitioner.

B. By an appropriate writ, order or direction, the
respondents may kindly be to not to relieve the
petitioner from his present posting place i.e. Government
Senior Secondary School, Dangiyawas, Jodhpur, District
Jodhpur as he holding the charge of ANO of Naval Unit
NCC.

C. By an appropriate writ, order or direction, the respondents may kindly be to permit the petitioner to work continue at Government Senior Secondary School, Dangiyawas, Jodhpur, District Jodhpur as School Lecturer (Political Science) as he holding the charge of ANO of Naval Unit NCC with all consequential benefits.

D. Any other appropriate writ, order direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner.

E. Writ petition filed by the petitioner may kindly be allowed with costs."

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been granted NCC commission on 04.08.2023 (Annex.2) and is posted at Government Senior Secondary School Dangiyawas, Jodhpur with a batch of 50 students under NCC. He submits that by the impugned order dated 10.07.2026 (Annex.3), the respondents have transferred the petitioner from Government Senior Secondary School Dangiyawas, Jodhpur to PM Shri Government Senior Secondary School, Setrawa, Phalodi, where no NCC activities take place, which is in contravention to their own circulars dated 04.08.2005, 30.09.1999, 19.11.1974, 08.11.1994, 24.02.2000 & 18.11.1994. He submits that pursuant to the said circulars, the respondents ought not to have transferred the petitioner to a school, where NCC activities are not undertaken.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents is not in a position to refute the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. This Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition while observing that in case no NCC activities are carried out at the new place of posting i.e. PM Shri Government Senior Secondary School, Setrawa, Phalodi, the impugned order dated 10.07.2026 (Annex.3) shall not be operated by the respondents, qua the petitioner, in case the circulars relied upon by the petitioner are still in operation.

5. In case, the contention of the petitioner is found to be incorrect, the respondents would be at liberty to operate the order dated 10.07.2026.
