1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 10.07.2026 (Annex.4), the petitioner has been transferred from Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School, Phephana District Hanumangarh to PM Shri Mahatma Gandhi Govt. School, Raisinghnagar, Sri Ganganagar which is about at a distance of more than 240 kms away from the present place of posting. He also submits that vacancies are available with the respondents at District Hanumangarh from where the petitioner is respondents

and the respondents could have accommodated the petitioner at the vacant place.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that vide office order dated 17.07.2026, a Grievance Redressal Committee has been constituted in respect to transfer of single women/widow/divorcee/employees suffering from terminal illness and various other issues. He submits that the petitioner can file his representation before the Grievance Committee, which will consider the representation on the grounds raised by the petitioner in an expeditious manner and this petition can be disposed at this stage.

3. Heard.

4. Taking into consideration the grievance raise herein and also the fact that a Grievance Redressal Committee has been constituted vide office order dated 17.07.2026, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to file his representation before the Grievance Redressal Committee within a period of '7 days' from today and the Committee shall decide the representation within a period of 'two weeks' thereafter, strictly in accordance with law by way of passing a speaking order.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the writ petition is disposed of.
