The instant misc. petition under Section 528 of the BNSS has been filed by the petitioner with the limited prayer that the Investigating Agency be directed to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in F.I.R. No.14/2026, registered at Police Station Loonkarnsar, District Bikaner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn the attention of this Court to the order dated 07.07.2026 passed in ***S.B. Criminal Misc. Bail Application No.3936/2026***, wherein it has been

clearly observed that the Investigating Officer shall conclude the investigation by 23.07.2026 and file the complete final report before the learned trial Court.

Learned Public Prosecutor submitted that the Investigating Agency is already conducting a fair and impartial investigation. However, if any material is brought on record by the petitioner, the same shall be considered by the prosecution strictly in accordance with law before completion of the investigation.

In light of the aforesaid assurance of the learned Public Prosecutor, the present misc. petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Officer to conduct the investigation fairly, conclude the same by 23.07.2026 and submit the report.

With these observations, the present misc. petition under Section 528 of the BNSS stands disposed of accordingly.
