1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been transferred six times from 2023 to 2026. He further submits that vide the same order i.e. 10.07.2026 (Annex.6), the petitioner has been transferred from Tehsil Gogunda, District Udaipur to District Alwar and on the same date, vide another order dated 10.07.2026 (Annex.7), the petitioner was transferred from District Alwar to District Udaipur.



2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents may be directed to decide the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner, while granting the petitioner limited protection.
3. Counsel for the respondents, does not object the submissions advanced by the petitioner's counsel.
4. In view of the submissions made, the petitioner would be at liberty to file a representation before the respondents within a period of 'two weeks' from today and the same shall be decided by the respondents within a period of 'four weeks' thereafter while passing a speaking order, strictly in accordance with law.
5. Till the decision of the representation, the impugned orders dated 10.07.2026 (Annex.6 & Annex.7), shall remain stayed qua the petitioner.
6. It is made clear that if the petitioner fails to submit the representation within a period of two weeks, the interim order granted by this Court shall stand vacated.
