I. A. No.01/2025 :

1. Matter comes up on an application for impleadment of Chail Singh S/o Shri Rawat Singh as party respondent.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant states that the notice impugned in the present writ petition has been issued in pursuance of the application filed by the applicant-Chail Singh in the appeal. It is thus, stated that applicant-Chail Singh is a necessary and proper party to the present proceedings.

3. The application though opposed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, however, he is not able to deny the fact that long term proceedings are pending between the petitioner and applicant-Chail Singh and notice issued is direct outcome of the same.

4. In view of the above and for the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it would be in the interest of justice that the present writ petition be disposed of, while directing the Additional Divisional Commissioner, Jodhpur to decide the pending Appeal No.04/2025 expeditiously and in a time bound manner.

6. Learned counsel for the applicant/respondent does not oppose the said prayer.

7. In view of the submissions made at bar, the present writ petition is allowed with a direction to the Additional Divisional Commissioner, Jodhpur to decide the pending Appeal No.04/2025 as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, without granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties.

8. In the meantime, till the final decision of the appeal before the Court of Additional Divisional Commissioner, Jodhpur, the

interim order dated 14.08.2025 passed by this Court shall remain in currency.

9. It is made clear that this order shall not construed as directing Additional Divisional Commissioner, Jodhpur to decide the appeal in any particular manner, but only in accordance with law.
