1. While arguing the I.A. No. 1 /2025, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that efforts have been made to obtain the certified copy of the award from the Arbitrator.
2. In response, the learned Arbitrator has informed that the entire record has been returned to the respondent-HDFC Bank, and the respondent-HDFC Bank did not issue the certified copy to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the appellant further submits that only certified copy of the award available with the appellant non-claimant has already been filed in the proceedings initiated under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. A certified photocopy has been filed before this Court.
4. In view of the reasons mentioned, the application for dispensing with the requirement of certified copy of the award dated 25.02.2016 is waived at this stage.
5. The matter comes up on an application I.A. No.02/2025 filed under Section 37 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act for delay in deposition of Court fees. The delay in depositing the Court fees is condoned.
6. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.
7. Let the record of the Court Below be summoned.
8. Rest of the defects have already been removed.
9. Office to check and proceed.
