1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per Rule 18 of the Civil Post Rules, 1922, the prescribed procedure has to be followed before terminating any employee in terms of the said rules.
2. However, the services of the petitioner have been terminated vide order dated 05.06.2025 (Annex.8) without even serving any notice on her.
3. In view of the submission made, Issue notice.
4. Issue notice of stay application also.

5. Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due. Notices be made returnable on 03.09.2025.

Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.

6. Meanwhile, the effect and operation of order dated 05.06.2025 (Annexure-8) shall remain stayed.

7. However, the respondents shall be at liberty to proceed afresh in accordance with Rule 18 of the Rules of 1922, if so desired.
