Matter comes up on an application for restoration of the writ
petition.

It is stated that a peremptory order dated 11.08.2023 was passed directing the petitioner to remove the defects on or before 04.09.2023.

Learned counsel submits that, however, despite making efforts, the defects could not be removed by the stipulated time, on account of which the writ petition was dismissed on 13.09.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, despite efforts made, compliance could not be effected on or before 13.09.2023 and, therefore, the writ petition came to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that necessary steps will be taken immediately after the restoration application is allowed.

In view of the above and for the reasons stated in the application, the restoration application is **allowed**.
